The Fire Marshal's Public Fire Safety Council requests that you announce the following simple but lifesaving message at the end of your broadcast or whenever possible:

**CHANGE YOUR CLOCK, CHANGE YOUR BATTERY**

**Voice Over** – Length: 30 seconds

Do you know when to change the batteries in your smoke alarm? To ensure your smoke alarms work when you need them, change your batteries at least once a year. Install a new battery of the proper type and never use rechargeable batteries. On Sunday, October 27, we will be moving our clocks back. As a reminder, when you change your clock, change your batteries too. It could save you and your family. A message from the Fire Marshal's Public Fire Safety Council and this station.

**Voice over** – Length: 10 seconds

Replace the battery in all your smoke alarms at least once a year. As a reminder, when you change your clock on Sunday, October 27, change your batteries too. It could save your life. A message from the Fire Marshal's Public Fire Safety Council and this station.
